Contract has been completed for the Name change of Napier University to Edinburgh Napier University

Napier University have changed their name to Edinburgh Napier University. This change necessitated the complete replacement & rebranding of all of their existing internal and external signage which displayed the old name and logo.



The name change is intended to firmly associate the University with Edinburgh and to use the Capital's reputation to encourage more students to the University. The city of Edinburgh is a key motivating factor which they believe will further enhance Napier's strength and reputation for staff, students, businesses and local community.

The 25th of February was the re-launch date which was a culmination of Parliamentary approval and will be a landmark in the University's history.

Babcock Integrated Technology

The Betty Building at Rosyth Dockyard which housed the Babcock Design & Technology facility has had new stainless steel lettering mounted to reflect a change of name. The new name is Babcock Integrated Technology which is now prominently displayed vertically on the outside of two sides of the main stairwell.

The lettering is fabricated and formed from heavy gauge polished 316 stainless steel. The top of the signage is some 40 metres above ground level which required very specialized personnel and access equipment for a safe and cost effective installation.

This is only one of the high profile sign solutions that Sign Plus have successfully completed on the Dockyard complex in recent years.

Sign Plus have for the Assemblies of 2008 and 2009 supplied and erected two large vertical banners on the frontage of the Assembly Hall building. These banners are over 14 meters in height and are designed to withstand the elements to which they are exposed in this prominent location.
