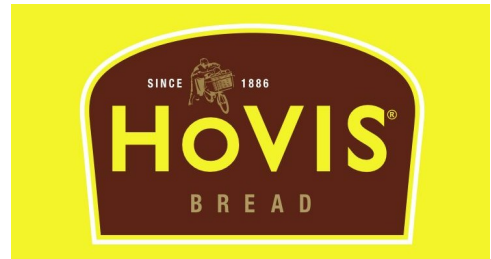

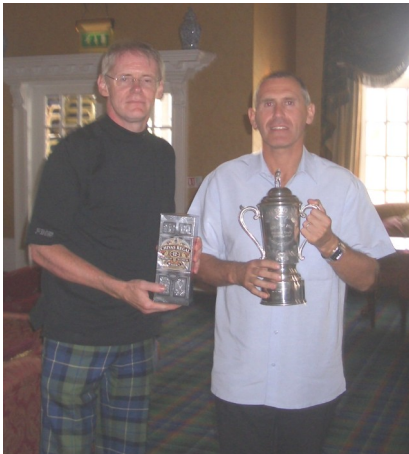
The Sign Plus skilled and experienced team has successfully completed over 500 vehicles in the past year - an average of 2 vehicles per day.
